## Standards

## Objective

- Students will define the word "family."
- Students will identify/describe each member of their own family.
- Students will take a picture of their family members to use in a presentation.
- Students will use Lumio for their presentations.
- Students will write 2-3 sentences identifying the different properties of what families are, what families have, and what families can be.

## Procedure

1. The students will begin by defining the word Family.
2. After the students complete that, they will then identify/describe each member of their own family.
3. After they have described their family, they will then take a picture of each family member to include in a presentation.
4. The students will develop their presentations using Lumio.
5. At the end of their presentation they will explain in 2-3 sentences, the different properties of what families are, what families have, and what families can be.

## Extension Activity

While the teacher facilitates, students will use Zoom to go over their presentation with their classmates. They will then have a dialogue about the differences/similarities of each of their families. The overall goal will be to have students understand and respect their individual differences and similarities.
