



Objectives

- Students will be able to learn about the history of various countries across the globe
- Students will be able to identify how culture, geography, and history shape a community
- Students will be able to use Google Slides to share presentations about different cultures

Materials

- Google Slides
- Internet Connected Device
- Resources for students to use as research tools

Standards

Procedure

1. Students will learn about the history of various countries across the globe. They will explore how culture, geography, and history shape a community. They will also explore how world communities are the same and different.
2. Students will collaborate and share their ideas with their teacher and peers through real-time discussion on Google Slides.
3. Students will take on different components of each country to create their presentations. For example: food, language, geography, celebrations, attire, etc.

Technology Skills Needed

- Knowledge of how to use Google Slides: Creating content, sharing content with students, collaborating in real-time
- Knowledge of how to share resources with students (via Classroom, E-mail, etc.)



Extension Activity

- Task students Task with the challenge of presenting their slides presentation. They can share their presentations with Google Meet.
- Once students have created a presentation for one country, have them move on to a different country and follow the same procedure.
