



## Compound Words with Sphero Mini

### Materials:

- Charged Sphero Mini
- Compound word worksheet
- Pencil
- Personal Device
- SpheroEdu

**Description:** Using the drive or draw mode students will match the compound word formula with the correct picture. Students will then write out the compound word.

**Teacher Technology Skills:** Sphero Mini, SpheroEdu

### Standards:

#### Next Generation ELA Learning Standards

- 2L4d: Use knowledge of the meaning of individual words to predict the meaning of compound words (e.g., birdhouse, lighthouse, housefly, bookshelf, notebook, bookmark)

### Procedure:

1. Using the compound word worksheet have the students draw a line connecting the compound word formula and picture.
2. Then, have the students connect the compound word formula to the picture it represents by moving the Sphero Mini between them using drive or draw mode.
3. Mark the picture with an "X" once matched.

**Note:** This can also be done by spreading the word formulas and pictures out on a large flat surface and having the students move the Sphero from formula to picture.

### Extension Activity:

- Have the students create their own compound words.
- Have the students change the color of the Sphero once it reaches the correct word.

## Compound Words (Sphero Mini)

Directions: 1. Connect the compound word formula and the correct picture with a line. 2. Next, connect the compound word formula to the picture it represents by driving the Sphero Mini between them and marking the picture with an "X". 3. Once you have connected the pictures and word formulas, write out the compound word.
