

How can you be a **S.M.A.R.T** Digital Citizen?



S

SAFE

Keep all personal information safe and secret. Avoid sharing your address, phone number, school name or photos with anyone online.

M

MEET

Avoid meeting up with people that you talk to online. Only meet someone that you have a parent or guardian's permission to connect with.

A

ACCEPTING

Be cautious about accepting emails, messages, files, and pictures from people online. If you are not sure what something is, ask an adult.

R

RELIABLE

Double check all information that you read or see online. Some information may not be true or people may lie about who they are.

T

TELL

If you see anything online or have any interactions online that make you feel uncomfortable or worried, be sure to tell an adult that you trust.
