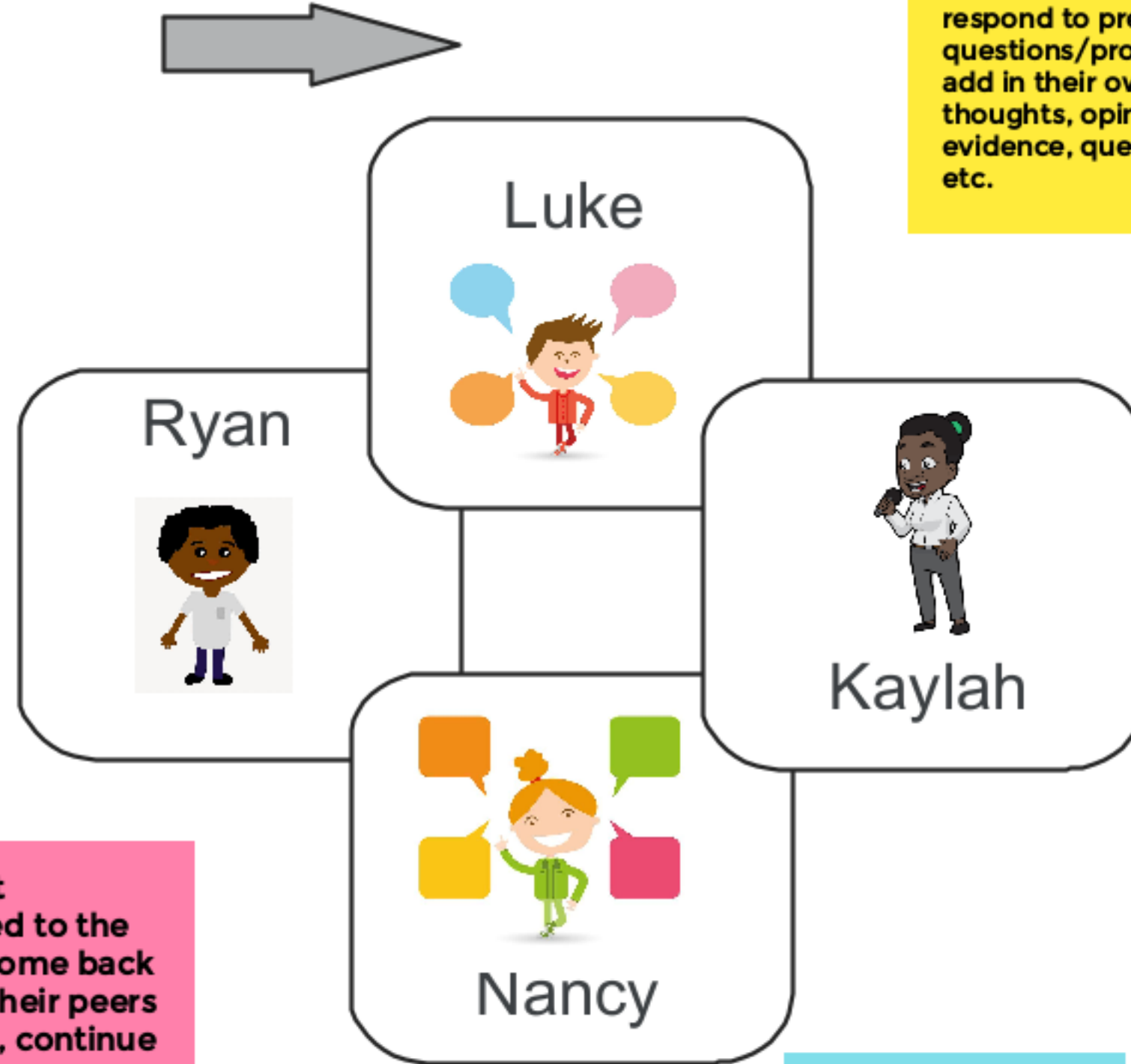


# "Digital Fishbowl" Example

A digital fishbowl is a strategy for organizing larger group discussions. A small group participates in the discussion while the rest of the class listens and responds.



Students respond to participants on sticky notes. Students can respond to pre-made questions/prompts or add in their own thoughts, opinions, evidence, questions, etc.

Pro tip- use different colored sticky notes to create categories- either each discussion participant gets their own color or you can group it by questions, evidence, opinions, etc. You choose!

Those that contributed to the Jam can come back and read their peers responses, continue adding comments and/or continue the discussion outside of class.

Students that participated in the discussion can come to this page after the discussion to see what was posted by the rest of the class.
